INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

WE REQUIRE THAT YOUR PRICE BE OFFERED ON THE FORMS PROVIDED so that an accurate comparative evaluation can be made.

Inspection: After delivery of the equipment, MMU will make final inspection and advise bidder whether or not the equipment appears to be acceptable in accordance with the bid. If not acceptable, MMU will identify the apparent defects in writing. Bidder shall immediately take such measures as are necessary to remedy all defects.

Application for Payment: After bidder has remedied all defects, if any, to the satisfaction of MMU, furnished all special services and delivered all maintenance and operating instructions, schedules, guarantees, certificates of inspection, and other documents (all as required by the bid documents) bidder may then make application for payment.

Payment: If, on the basis of the final inspection and review of the Application for Payment and accompanying documentation, MMU is satisfied that the equipment is in accordance with the bid documents, that special services have been furnished as required and that bidder's other obligations under the bid documents have been fulfilled, MMU shall, within thirty days after receipt thereof, pay bidder the amount of the bid awarded.

The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to make all decisions for the benefit of the Municipal Utilities, acting as sole and undisputed judge of what is beneficial to the Municipal Utilities.
